Support the transposition of acquis communautaire to national legislation of the Enlargement countries










Graphical location of the workshops in 2014







E&IA workshops and trainings 2014: location per country






Posts filled per nationality





The task of the EURL for feed additives is to evaluate the analytical method for detection and quantification as proposed by the applicant for authorisation.

The authorisation can only be granted after a scientific evaluation demonstrating that the additive has no harmful effects on human and animal health and on the environment
